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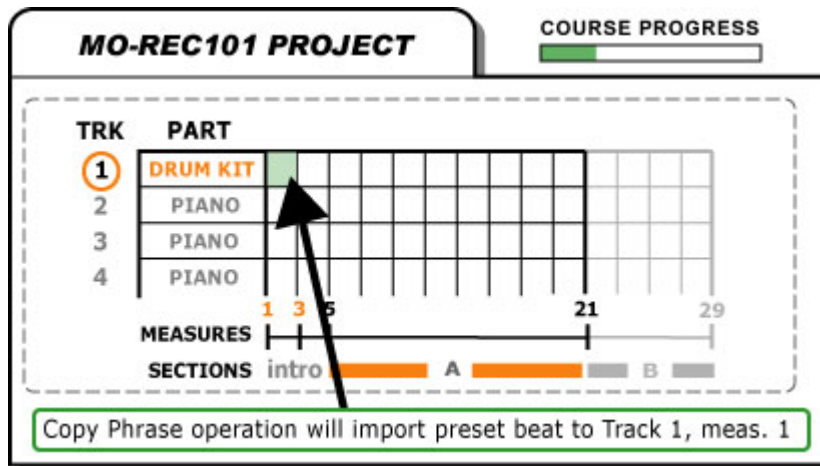
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# Excerpt from Chapter 4: Motif Recording 101

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## Import a Preset Beat (Copy Phrase)

[Notice the graphic below. It serves as a conceptual snapshot of the course/assignments from a high level so you can take a peek at what we will ultimately be accomplishing prior to beginning each procedure]



1. Press the SONG button.
2. Select the Track you wish to import the beat to using the appropriate TRACK SELECT button [Select Track 1 if you are following the project].
3. Grab the Motif Data List booklet, and open it to the Preset Phrase list (pg. 55 for ES; pg. 41 for Classic). In the ES booklet, find Category DR2, Phr# 020; in the Classic booklet find No. 89).
4. In the Motif, select the PHRASE tab (F5).
5. On the Copy Phrase screen, use the ARROW buttons to move the cursor and the DATA DIAL to select the numbers shown below in **bold** print (Classic owners ignore the "DR2" field and enter "089" instead of "020").

PHRASE [**DR2:020**]

TRACK **[01]** MEAS: **[001]**

6. Press the ENTER button to complete the operation.
7. Press the TOP button (labeled 'locate') to return the Song counter to measure 001:01.
8. Select the PLAY tab (F1 button).
9. Press the PLAY button to hear the beat. If you entered the values in step 4 correctly, the beat should play for two measures and stop.
